Kulturprojekte Berlin has been commissioned by the mayor of Berlin to coordinate the Berlin Theme Year ‘**20 Years since the Fall of the Wall**’. Kulturprojekte Berlin is a not-for-profit organisation affiliated with the Berlin state government that works for the promotion, networking and mediation of art and culture. The offices of the central Berlin Project Fund for Cultural Education are also here. Every project is managed by a team specially put together for that project, ensuring that both the skills in terms of content and the experience drawn from long years of involvement in Berlin’s cultural networks are consolidated to provide an optimal result.
